The next General Municipal Election will be held on Tuesday, April 2, 2024. There will be many items to vote on, but Airport Drive Trustees will not be on the ballot. On that day, terms will expire for Trustees Mark Rains, Kara Charbonneau and James Paul. We have three residents that filed for candidacy for the election: Mark Rains, Claren Holmes, and Denise Winans. Because Village residents approved not holding an election if the number of candidates equals the number of open positions, the candidates shall assume the responsibilities of their offices at the same time and manner as if they had been elected. Mark Rains, Claren Holmes and Denise Winans will be sworn in at the Special Meeting in April, after the election. The March 28th Meeting will be the last meeting for Trustees Jim Paul and Kara Charbonneau. Jim Paul has served the Village well for 22 years as a Trustee and as a past Chairman. Kara Charbonneau has served from 2022 to 2024 and always made the needs and concerns of our residents her top priority. Thank you Jim and Kara for jobs well done!



Meetings for the Village of Airport Drive are held at the Municipal Building on the 4th Thursday of each month (except November & December), and are open to the public, unless posted as Closed Session. Everyone is welcome to attend meetings; it's the best way to stay informed of events in Airport Drive.

The Village Office is open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, unless posted as closed. When visiting the office, park in the lot south of the building and use the south door. *********

If you notice **any street lights not working**, call Liberty Utilities (Empire) at **800-206-2300** or the Village Office. Liberty will determine ownership and repair the light. *********



Republic Services has notified Airport Drive, per their contract, a modification of the current rate happened on the anniversary date of the agreement, January 1st, 2024. The annual CPI for Water, sewer and trash is 5.6%, however the maximum amount per agreement is 3%. This will bring the residential rate that is paid to Republic to \$11.69 per month and an additional

cart is \$5.46 per month.

Republic appreciates the partnership they have formed with Airport Drive and looks forward to another successful year. They value their relationship with the Village and pride themselves in providing excellent service to the citizens of Airport Drive. All **ditches must be maintained** by the resident. Trees, bushes, brush, debris, and leaves need to be kept out of the ditches so water will freely drain. *********

When the weather turns cold, it can bring a chill into our homes. Portable space heaters have become a popular way to supplement central heating or heat one room. If you plan to use portable electric space heaters, make sure to follow these tips and recommendations:

HEATER CHECKLIST

- Purchase a heater with the seal of a qualified testing laboratory.
- Keep the heater at least 3 feet (1 metre) away from anything that can burn, including people.
- Choose a heater with a thermostat and overheat protection.
- Place the heater on a solid, flat surface.
- Make sure your heater has an auto shut-off to turn the heater off if it tips over.
- Keep space heaters out of the way of foot traffic. Never block an exit.
- Keep children away from the space heater.
- Plug the heater directly into the wall outlet. Never use an extension cord.
- Space heaters should be turned off and unplugged when you leave the room or go to bed.

2023 was a great year!! Some personnel changes will soon be occurring with our staff, Deputy Linder has decided to take employment with her family's business, she will be greatly missed as she did an amazing job here in the Village and I wish her great success!!! In March, Cpl. Ben Carrier will take over duties as the night patrol Deputy. Cpl. Carrier will be a good addition to our group, he is an experienced officer and I know he will do an outstanding job. We have also added a Stalker Speed Trailer to assist with monitoring traffic speed and assist in high traffic areas. We were able to secure a grant through the Missouri Coalition for Roadway Safety - SWMO Coalition for the purchase of the trailer. I have received several positive comments from residents about the trailer; we are currently working on programming so that we can collect data to assist us in patrolling the Village better.

The 2023 Annual Report for the Village has been completed to keep our community informed of crime and traffic reporting as well as trends over the last couple years. If you would like to view a copy, please email me at tcrossley@jaspercountysheriff.org.

Deputies of the Jasper County Sheriff's Office responded to 1,137 calls for service within the Village, these



numbers do not include self initiated activities such as traffic enforcement, 619 traffic stops were conducted with 55 citations being issued and 564 warnings.

During the year our Deputies have received several recognitions for the community events which have been hosted in Airport Drive. We have several ideas for events this year, we would really like to encourage the residents to come out and participate with us. New Sewer Rates go into effect February 1, 2024



On January 25, 2024 the Trustees adopted Ordinance 01-24 to increase sewer rates. Sewer rates had remained unchanged since September 2020.

The chart below shows the new Base Charges.

The rate charged per 1,0000 gallons of water used will increase from \$3.25 to \$4.25.

Building Permits & Contractors

The average used for billing is from usage at each property for the months of January, February, and March. We will request reports from the water companies in April. Once new averages are calculated, they will be used for the following approximate 12 months for sewer billing. The average usage of all residential properties is used for well users and newly constructed residences.

If you had a water leak, filled a pool or hot tub, or experienced an unusually high water usage in January, February, or March, please contact the office. We always try to determine the most accurate amount of water entering the sewer system and bill accordingly.

The increase in the usage charge will be used for future maintenance and expansion endeavors. The Infiltration & Inflow Study is complete. Using smoke testing, cameras, and acoustic sounding, TREKK Designs provided a list of possible infiltration openings that will need to be repaired. Overall the sewer system is in good shape. But it is also over 30 years old in some areas. It's better to prepare than to have to repair.

If you plan to work on your home, business, or property, please contact the Village Office before any work begins. A Building Permit is required if you are building a new home or business, changing the footprint of a structure, building or tearing out walls, work that involves electric wiring and/or plumbing, building decks or fences. No building or structure shall be erected, moved, added to or structurally altered without a permit. All contractors must be licensed to work in Airport Drive. If your contractor is not licensed in Airport Drive, ask them to contact the office. They must provide proof of general liability and workman's comp insurance. This helps to protect the residents and businesses in Airport Drive.



The Board of Trustees amended Section 400.050 of the Code of Ordinances on October 26, 2023, amending fees for plan reviews and inspections. The schedule of fees is below.

The fee for a Building Permit and Site Plan Review for Non-Commercial/Industrial (Residential) is \$125.00, plus \$30.00 for each anticipated inspection. The inspection fees are collected as a deposit. Any unused deposit will be refunded after the approved final inspection. Any unpaid fees will need to be paid prior to issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy.

The fee for Commercial and/or Industrial Site Plan Review is \$275.00. Inspections for commercial projects is \$55.00 each.

The Fee for a Sewer Tap inspection is \$150.00, for residential or commercial projects.

New fences require a permit, \$60.00 for residential properties and \$110.00 for commercial/industrial properties. The fees are for two inspections; a lot inspection and a final. Repairing an existing fence does not require a permit.

A roofing permit is required to re-roof a house. The fee is \$60.00 for two inspections for residential properties, for the underlayment and the final.


