Election News

The General Municipal Election in April 2021 will be a little different this year. On April 6th, terms will end for Trustees Terry Myers and Ray Bryant. However, they were the only candidates to file for Trustee, so as of April 6th, they will continue to serve as Trustees for two more years. Airport Drive will not have to hold an election because in November 2018, Airport Drive voters passed Proposition "A", that stated if the number of candidates that have filed for offices is equal to the number of positions to be filled, no election would need to be held. This will save Airport Drive the expense of an election. The Municipal Building will most likely still be used as a polling location on April 6th for county and/or school board questions.

There will also be an election at the Municipal Building on February 2, 2021 for a Bond question from the Jasper County Public Water Service District #1. See page 5 for more information.

It is a violation and will result in a citation if not cleaned up in a timely manner.

To Airport Drive Residents served by Jasper County Public Supply Water District #1 A Statement from Attorney Bill McCaffree Water District Election - Voters to Decide

There will be an election on February 2, 2021 to decide whether to authorize the District to issue bonds which will permit low-cost financing for improvements that are needed over the next 20 years. This explanation is made to explain why the new Board of Directors has asked for submission of the question to the voters. Transmission lines now approach 50 years of age. CVC pipe produced when the system was built does not tolerate age as well as new thicker walled products. Significant portions of the District's transmission lines need to be replaced and to maintain appropriate hydraulics, some lines need to be enlarged. The District's engineering firm is concerned about the need for a new well and maintenance and updating of other facilities including towers. The District's metering equipment is approaching need of replacement. The proposal before the voters would authorize borrowing to pay for the necessary repair, maintenance and installation of new equipment, as well as for the engineers to advise the District and for expenses to maintain service at reasonable cost in the future. There will be no taxes. If and when money is borrowed it will be paid from the revenues from the sale of water.

Substantial changes in management of the District have occurred. There are new Directors and employees. If you are having any problem at all with your water service, please call the office at 417-781-8844. The District will continue to operate on a not-for-profit basis.

There will be two polling places in the District for the election. One will be in Airport Drive, 25150 Demott Dr., Airport Drive, MO 64801 and the second will be the Fir Road Christian Church. The Tuckahoe Drive and the Carl Junction II precincts are to vote at Airport Drive. All others are to vote at Fir Road.

Building Permits Reminders......

If you are working on your home or property, or you hire someone to do the work for you, please contact the Village Office before work begins. A Building Permit is required if you are building a new home, tearing out or building new walls, re-wiring or re-plumbing, building decks or fences. No building or structure shall be erected, moved, added to, or structurally altered without a permit issued by the Village Office.

The fee for a Building Permit is \$125.00. Also, a deposit of \$25.00 for each anticipated inspection is collected. Unused deposit is returned, but any addition inspections must be paid for prior to issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy.

The fee for a sewer tap inspection is \$150.00.

A new fence requires a permit. A fee of \$50.00 covers two inspections, a lot and a final inspection.

A roofing permit is required to re-roof a house. The fee is \$50.00 for two inspections: to inspect the underlayment and a final inspection.

Contactors are required to purchase General Contractor or Subcontractor licenses to work in Airport Drive. The fees for the licenses are \$100.00 per year for General Contractors and \$75.00 per year for Subcontractors. Licenses are valid from January 1st to December 31st, fees are pro-rated if not for a full year. Section 605.045 of the Code lists the types and limits of insurance required for all contractors working in Airport Drive.


