The Board of Trustees have set a budget and we need to start planning for the Community Celebration in 2022, the 75th Birthday of Airport Drive. Projects in the Village...

The Board has been busy with several improvement projects. They are still discussing water line improvements with the Jasper County Public Water Service District #1. The asphalt overlay for roads in Tabor Woods and White Oak Estates will be started after water line improvements are completed.

Village Engineer Jerald Norton is working on conceptual plans and cost estimates for street projects on East Bland and West Bland Avenues. The Trustees plan to widen the roadway from the intersection of East Bland and Elm to Main Street for safety reasons. The West Bland Avenue project is to correct water drainage issues.

The Briarwood Subdivision, west of Fountain Estates Subdivision, is progressing. Briarwood is platted for 32 building lots. No building permits have been issued yet, but the developer is close to having required improvements completed.

The building permit has been issued for a new Dollar General Store to be constructed on the southeast corner of Fir Road and Lone Elm Avenue. Site work should start very soon. Overland Engineering stated it would take four to five months to complete the new store. There will be a left-turn lane added to Fir Road for the entrance to the business.

Updates & Reminders

The Village Office is open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, unless posted as closed. When visiting the office, park in the lot south of the building and use the south door.

There is a **Medication Drop Off Box** inside the Municipal Building to properly dispose of unused or expired medications. The box is provided by the Alliance of Southwest Missouri. Jasper County Sheriff's Officers will dispose of the medications.

Schools will be back in session before we know it.

Classes will **resume** for students in Carl Junction and Webb City School Districts on the same day, Monday, **August 23**, **2021**. Please watch out for our smallest Villagers this summer!

Just a reminder, you can pay your sewer bill or pay for Building Permits, Business or Contractors licenses, or any fee by credit card or e-check at the Village Office. Or you can visit our website at www.airportdrivemo.com. There are links on the home-page, on the Residents page and on the Forms page to access the payment system. Click on the blue button, then click on the

credit cards to access the payment page.

There is a fee for the service: a flat fee of \$1.75 for e-checks or \$1.75 for transactions up to \$60.00 for Visa and Mastercard;



3% for transactions above \$60.00. You will receive email confirmation for every transaction; and save the cost of the stamp, envelope, and the check.

The Village of Airport Drive depends on our businesses to generate Sales Tax to pay for services in our community. Some of the services are police and fire protection, leaf pickup in the fall, snow plowing, tree trimming, street lights, general repairs and maintenance, and Village Staff. Airport Drive does not collect property taxes, so sales tax is the revenue source for almost everything. Even with the increase in January 2021, Airport Drive's sales tax rate is lower than all of the surrounding cities. When you can, please shop at our local businesses.

Spring Clean Up Follow Up

Spring Clean Up has come and gone. Do you still have stuff that you would like to get rid of?

Republic Services offers several options for items that could not be collected during Spring Clean Up. Check out their website for special containers to mail items for recycling: sharps and needles, electronics & e-waste, LED & fluorescent bulbs.

To recycle electronics & E-waste items with Republic Services: a Box Mail-Back Program is available. Box sizes range from singular items to full pallet. Items include cell phones and telephones, computers, hard drives, monitors, personal digital assistants, power tools, scanners, printers, fax machines, routers, servers, tablets, and TVs. This service is a safe way to insure any data in devices is destroyed. Republic Services wipes the data 7 times before disposing of equipment responsibly. Upon completion, a Certificate of Recycling that certifies compliance with regulatory standards is returned to customer.

The City of Joplin Recycling Center at 1310 West A Street, near the intersection of A and Porter Avenue (several blocks east of Maiden Lane) is operated and fully owned by the City of Joplin. Currently all drop off items are accepted for free. The Center does not pay for items that are dropped off.

Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Facility is located by the Joplin Recycling Center at 1310 West A Street and open the same hours. This facility accepts these categories of Limited Household Hazardous Waste:

- *Aerosol Cans including aerosol paint cans
- *Automotive Parts except oil, filters & antifreeze
- *Batteries
- *Home Maintenance Products except paint
- *Household Cleaners
- *Lawn & Garden Products
- *Mercury Debris
- *Pool & Spa Supplies
- *Propane Tanks, Metal Cylinder & Fire Extinguishers

KEEP PRODUCTS IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINERS. DO NOT MIX PRODUCTS. LABEL ANYTHING NOT IN ITS ORIGINAL CONTAINER. MAKE SURE LIDS ARE TIGHT.

The HHW Facility Does Not Accept:

- *<u>Antifreeze</u> accepted at Lube-N-Oil, 906 W 7th St. and Mitchell's Mobil 1 Lube Express, 2525 S. Rangeline Road
- *Fluorescent Bulbs wrap with tape and set out with trash. Republic Services offers recycling for a fee.
- *Household Paint: Stir in sawdust or cat litter. Do not replace the lid, allow to dry. Set out with trash.
- *Motor Oil, Transmission Fluid, Gear Oil & Oil Filters
 O'Reilly Auto Parts Stores accepts up to 5 gallons of used fluids & filters, and automotive batteries free of charge. Oil can not have any water in it. Joplin HHW Facility will accept oil that has been contaminated with other liquids or solids.
- *Sharps-Lancets, Needles, Syringes Place sharps in plastic detergent bottle with bleach water; replace the lid; tape shut; write "SHARPS" on the bottle and place in the trash. Medical offices should call commercial medical waste hauler.


