# **Next Election - August 8, 2023**

A reminder! There will be an election held Tuesday, August 8, 2023 at the Municipal Building, 25150 Demott Drive, Joplin, for all registered voters residing in Airport Drive. There are two questions on the ballot.

### Proposition A

Proposition A allows that in the event that the number of candidates running for any Municipal Election is equal to the number of open positions, that no election shall be required. This was first approved by voters in 2018. It saves the Village the cost of an election when there is no need. This provision must be approved by the voters every six years. Since this provision was approved, no elections were held in April 2020 and April 2023. The average cost paid by Airport Drive for April Elections since 2013 is \$483.97.

### Proposition B

Proposition B asks if Airport Drive shall impose an additional sales tax of three percent (3%) on all retail sales of Adult Use, "Non-Medicinal", Marijuana sold in the Village of Airport Drive. This additional tax was approved in April of 2023 by voters in Jasper County and the cities of Joplin, Carl Junction, Carthage, Neosho, and Webb City. It would be collected on top of a 6-cent state sale tax that was part of Constitutional Amendment 3, passed by voters in November. This sales tax would not be applied to Medical Marijuana sales or anything else sold in Airport Drive. The Missouri Municipal League suggests each dispensary selling recreational marijuana would generate revenue of \$100,000 to \$150,000 annually for a town assessing a 3% sales tax on the product.

## **Updates & Reminders**

Meetings for the Village of Airport Drive are held at the Municipal Building on the fourth Thursday of each month (except November and December), and open to the public, unless posted as Closed Session. Everyone is welcome to attend meetings; it's the best way to stay informed of events in Airport Drive.

If you would like to receive your **sewer bill by email**, please contact the Village Office at (417) 623-6744 or send an email to Sue@airportdrivemo.com.

Unless posted otherwise, the **speed limit** on Village roadways is **20 MPH**. As the weather warms up, please watch out for residents, young and old, walking and bike riding.

If you notice any street lights not working, call Liberty Utilities (Empire) at 800-206-2300 or the Village Office. Liberty will determine ownership and repair the light.

Before you burn limbs, brush or yard waste, call Carl Junction Fire Protection District at 417-649-6062.

In lieu of a burn permit, you are required to contact CJ Fire District to confirm the conditions are okay for burning and to let them know when and where you plan to burn.

All **ditches must be maintained** by the resident. Trees, bushes, brush, debris, and leaves need to be kept out of the ditches so water will freely drain.

# Sewer Usage Numbers

We have received water usage numbers for residents and businesses for January, February & March of 2023. We calculated the new usage numbers based on the information from the water companies. The new numbers will be used for the June 2023 sewer billing cycle; and then for the next year. If you have questions about your bill, or question your new average, please contact the office.

### **Sewer Study News**

Airport Drive has begun an Infiltration & Inflow Study of the sewer system. The Flow Monitoring portion of the study is complete.

The next process is Smoke Testing. Residents will be notified by door hanger notices to be distributed on July 13th & 14th. Weather permitting, the smoke testing will take place the week after.

Acoustic Sounding will be performed the first part of August.

The results of the smoke testing and acoustic sounding ratings will determine what line segments and the total square footage of pipe that will need to be closed circuit TV'd. This will show if lines need cleaned or repaired.

We will try to keep everyone updated to avoid any surprises.

If you plan to work on your home, business, or property, please contact the Village Office before any work begins. A Building Permit is required if you are building a new home or business, changing the footprint of a structure, building or tearing out walls, work that involves electric wiring and/or plumbing, building decks or fences. No building or structure shall be erected, moved, added to or structurally altered without a permit issued by the Village Office.

The fee for a Building Permit is \$125.00, plus \$25.00 for each anticipated inspection. The inspection fees are collected as a deposit. Any unused deposit will be refunded after the final inspection. Any additional fees will need to be paid.

The Fee for a Sewer Tap inspection is \$150.00.

A new fence requires a permit, costing \$50.00, for two inspections; a lot inspection and a final.

Repairing an existing fence does not require a permit.

A roofing permit is required to re-roof a house. The fee is \$50.00 for two inspections, for the underlayment and the final.

Go to <u>www.airportdrivemo.com</u> for applications for building permits, sewer tap permits, and Contractor's Licenses.

All contractors must be licensed to work in Airport Drive. If your contractor is not listed above, ask them to contact the office to obtain a license. They must provide proof of general liability and workman's comp insurance. This helps to protect the residents and businesses in Airport Drive.
